Changes – CPIM V8.0



- ▶ One exam
 - Exam consists of 150 Q's
 - 20 are test the test questions
 - Time limitation is 3 ½ hours (210minutes)
 - Computer base
- ▶ Heavier emphasis on topics:
 - Strategies
 - How they affect product/service delivery
 - S&OP
 - Demonstrates a more integrated approach Sales and Operations Planning to product delivery.

Changes – CPIM V8.0 (Cont.)

▶ Books –

- Three books (Book 1 – first 2 modules, book 2– covers 3 modules, and book 3 covers 3 modules)

▶ More instructional intensity than past

- ASCM recommended time for a 3hr. class is 45hrs.

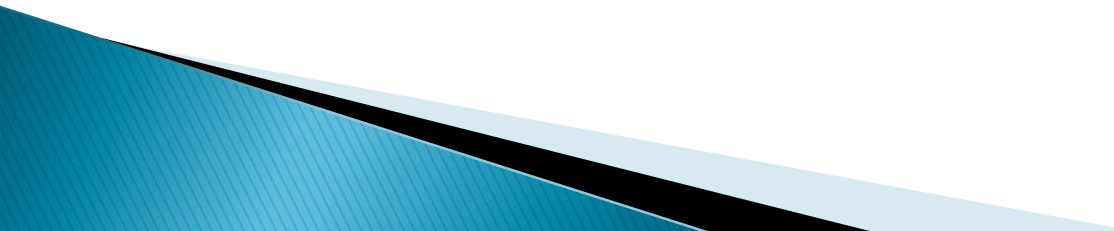
- If you have purchased an ATT for the CPIM–7.x (previous CPIM), your last day to sit for the exam is February 1, 2024

CTSC – The new dog in the fight to improve SCM

- ▶ This is a new certification that is being introduced.
- Primarily intended for professionals engaged in supply chain transformation
- Helping practitioners (certified CTSC) to help companies move towards SCM 4.0
 - Prepare companies for:
 - Natural disruptions – risk analysis and planning
 - Political disruptions
 - Economic disruptions

CTSC – The new dog in the fight to improve SCM

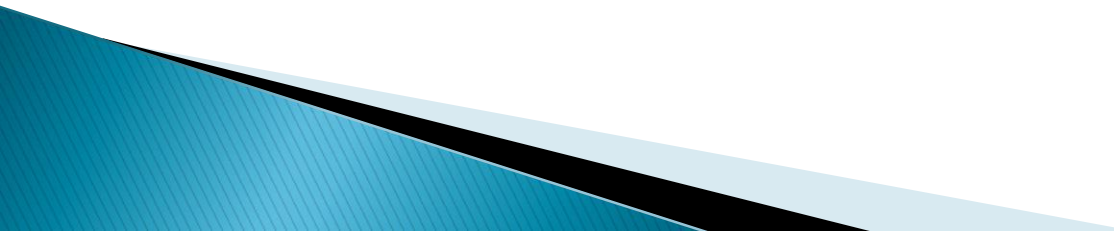

- This certification relies, heavily, on principles set for in SCOR and DCM (Digital Capabilities Model)
 - This is geared towards mid–senior level personnel
 - This is, as of this presentation, is digitally delivered to the students (not physical books – However, there are 4 digitally delivered books)
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SCOR-DS

- ▶ SCOR has undergone changes:
 - The SCOR-DS module is readily available to ASCM members
 - Powerful tool for evaluating companies, supply chain activities, and performance

I, highly, recommend, gaining an understanding of the SCOR-DS and the DCM models if working to the CTSC certification

Test taking techniques – For certifications

1. Use your learning system!!!!
 - a) Do the reading and assignments!
 - b) Take the on-line quizzes
 - Can be taken multiple times – should be able to pass quizzes with +80%
 - After initially taking quiz, wait some time and try again
 - c) Do the on-line practice tests!
 - a) These simulate the actual exam in terms of time and question type.
 - d) Rest – get a good night's sleep

Test taking techniques – For certifications (continued)

2. The Exam

1. The test is 150 questions
2. You have 210 minutes to complete
 - a) You'll have 1 minute 24 seconds (for those math geeks) to complete each question
 - b) Questions that you do not know, or are uncomfortable with can be flagged and you can go back to, depending on remaining time.
 - c) As an exercise – set a timer for 1 minute, start then close your eyes and do nothing until the alarm goes off
